Brad began his career with LMU in the Planning Department and spent the last 12 years in the Metering Department and heavily involved in the utilities PCB program and Substation inspection & maintenance programs.

Brad believes effective leadership is a team effort and a partnership between staff and management. Leadership at LMU has provided a great support system, his promotion is also a lateral career move with many new responsibilities and having team members committed to making LMU a great place to work will assure a smooth transition.

Core Value at LMU: Safety & Training

LMU's leadership team feel it's extremely important to communicate effectively with staff. Both Bob and Brad agree that effective safety communication are the building blocks of a good safety culture. Team members are responsible for ensuring that all equipment being used is in safe working condition and that all PPE is properly maintained and used and safe practices are followed in all aspects of our day-to-day operations, because of the team's efforts we reported "no lost time injuries" for 2021.

2022 LMU Projects

One of the projects is replacing all 69 KV relays in all seven LMU substations. Logansport Municipal should be using all new technologies in those substations by the end of the year. Also, a new AMI project is underway, along with new billing software, demolition of the existing generating plant and coal conveyor.

Other projects consist of wrapping up a 16MW solar project and a new Waelz Sustainable Products (WSP) facility. LMU began their AMI initiative in 2021 and hope to have the project up and running by 1st quarter 2023.
