Isolate and Insulate / Two Point Protection Safety Message

Safe gloving methods require strict adherence to the two-point protection principles of *isolate and insulate*. Two-point protection shall be used in all phases of rubber glove work.

Isolate Definition:

Isolate or isolating is defined as "avoiding any contact that would provide a path to ground or a difference of potential". When working on an energized conductors, always stay isolated.

No second point of contact

Examples of Isolate:
Aerial lifts
Platforms
Mats

Insulate Definition:

Insulate or insulating is defined as "installing non-conductive insulating protective (rubber goods) devices or equipment between or on energized conductors".

Use only company approved insulating devices.

Always: Follow the Two-Point Rule of Isolate and Insulate. Maintain minimum approach distances Work from approved devices Wear appropriate PPE
