



Arc Flash Awareness – Understanding the Hidden Hazard

Understanding Warning Labels and Boundaries

Arc flash labels provide critical safety information, including:

- Arc flash hazard warning
- Required PPE
- Incident energy levels
- Limited and restricted approach boundaries
- Equipment identification

Workers should never ignore or bypass warning labels. If information is missing or unreadable, stop and seek guidance.

Questions for the Crew

- What information do you typically look for on an arc flash label?
- What should you do if a label is damaged or missing?

Arc flash labels are there to protect workers. Read them, understand them, and follow the requirements every time.
