Applicants should have strong managerial skills, thorough understanding of electrical tariffs, contracts and billing procedures. Familiarity with principles and practices of power line construction, maintenance and substations. Proficient knowledge, application and use of basic computer software(s). Excellent ability to make informed immediate decisions in an emergency of highly stressful situations and willingness to work overtime in those emergency situations.

Proficient knowledge of environmental regulations and the requirements involved with reporting. Ability to co-ordinate and dispatch staff during emergency situations such as major power outages due to storms, etc. Familiarity of the RUS standards and APPA Safety Manual as adopted by the Electric Utility.

Education/Experience Requirements:

Bachelor's degree Operations Management or related Electrical field preferred.

Ten years of progressive experience in electric utility operations/engineering, including two to four years of supervisory experience required. Combination of like education and experience may be considered.

Understanding of Natural Gas Utilities is a plus.
