Verify Before You Touch

One of the most common causes of electrical accidents is relying on assumptions instead of testing. During troubleshooting, always verify the status of conductors, transformers, switches, and equipment using properly rated test instruments. Treat every conductor as energized until proven otherwise. Test your meter before and after use on a known energized source, and never bypass established testing procedures simply because "it should be dead." Verification protects everyone on the job and eliminates dangerous surprises.
